CALL FOR ENTRIES

The 2007 Regional Design Awards Program is being conducted in conjunction with the AIA Northwest and Pacific Regional Conference, being held September 26 through September 29, 2007 in Spokane, Washington.

ELIGIBILITY

All entrants of this year's regional Design Awards Program shall have won a Component or Chapter design award in a professional juried awards program. A project that receives an AIA National award, without entering state or local programs, is eligible. Projects must have received an award between January 1, 2002 and December 31, 2006 to be eligible. Projects must have been completed at the time the qualifying award was issued. People's Choice awards are not eligible. Projects that have won Legacy awards (e.g. 25 year awards) are not eligible. Any AIA member may, by exception, enter any project if they are from a Component that has not had an awards program of its own in more than 2 years. Entrants are limited to members of a Component within the Northwest and Pacific Region.

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee for the Regional Design Awards Program is \$165.00 per entry.

JUDGING CRITERIA

A professional jury will evaluate the entries on their own merit. Entries will be judged individually, not in competition with each other. The jury will evaluate submissions using a standard jury format. The primary resources for the jury will be the brief written material, photographs, and slides included in the submission.

AWARDS

The Region will use the terms "Honor Award," "Award of Merit" and "Citation." The jury shall solely determine the number of awards of each type.

As an organizational tool for the judging process, projects are grouped into the following categories:

1. Residential Buildings
2. Office, Commercial and Retail Buildings
3. Educational and Health Care Buildings
4. Institutional and Civic Buildings
5. Hospitality and Recreational Buildings
6. Renovation, Adaptive Reuse, and Preservation
7. Other Buildings and Interiors

PROCEDURE FOR SUBMITTING ENTRY

After the enclosed "Intent to Enter Forms" and Fees are received at the regional office, a confirmation of receipt and detailed submission instructions will be e-mailed. In general, the following material will be required to be submitted on a CD for each entry:

1. A Title Page in Word or PDF format.
2. Project Description: A one or two page narrative description in Word or PDF format.
3. A one-page list of images in Word or PDF format with a representative project image at the top of the page.
4. A minimum of four and a maximum of 25 images to include graphic information, (floor plans and optional site plan, and/or building sections and diagrams).
5. One publicity image.

In addition, a concealed information form and a materials release form will be included with the instructions.

Completed submittal is required as defined in the Submittal Instructions, Friday, August 31, 2007. There will be no exceptions.
