## **Lawrence B. Eighmy**

Mr. Eighmy serves as Founding and Managing Principal of THE STONE HOUSE GROUP. The US and China-based firm has provided sustainability, technical and facilities consulting services to over one hundred non-profit, academic and professional clients. Typical services include owner's representation for large capital projects, commissioning, utility master planning and LEED® administration and sustainable building design. THE STONE HOUSE GROUP, a 25-person firm, celebrates its ten year anniversary and continues to fulfill its vision of "Building Stewardship" by aligning the facilities of institutions with their mission.

THE STONE HOUSE GROUP has conducted energy projects at St. Paul's School, a boarding school in New Hampshire, to support its mission of environmental stewardship. The firm has a longstanding relationship with Gettysburg College, managing facilities, conducting green building projects, and supporting its finances. THE STONE HOUSE GROUP has significantly reduced The Hotchkiss School's energy costs and administered a LEED Gold project on the campus. THE STONE HOUSE GROUP has presented its findings to Boards of Trustees, Heads of Schools, Chief Financial Officers – as well as to student bodies.

After the May 2008 earthquake in Chengdu, THE STONE HOUSE GROUP conducted a four-day LEED charrette with the China Southwest Architectural Design and Research Institute Corporation Ltd., which focused on sustainable design and development of 200 schools in Sichuan Province. THE STONE HOUSE GROUP has targeted LEED Platinum for Beijing's iconic new pyramid-shaped building, Parkview Green, a 350,000 m<sup>2</sup> mixed-use retail, commercial and hotel. THE STONE HOUSE GROUP has overseen his staff in commissioning a 210,000 m<sup>2</sup> Nike manufacturing complex outside of Shanghai. THE STONE HOUSE GROUP has since entered into a joint venture with Rob Watson, the "Father of LEED" and his firm, EcoTech International.

Prior to founding THE STONE HOUSE GROUP, Mr. Eighmy previously worked as a facilities manager at Brown University, Carnegie Mellon University, and the Washington National Cathedral. He has experience working with architects as a master planner for a dozen institutions in the healthcare and education sectors. Mr. Eighmy has presented at National Association of Independent Schools and the Eastern Association of College and University Business Officers.

Mr. Eighmy serves as Chairman of the Board of the Green Schools Alliance, an organization that helps to reduce the carbon footprint of primary and secondary schools globally. He launched a preliminary study jointly between the World Resources Institute and the Green Schools Alliance to provide a Greenhouse Gas Protocol for Schools, setting an international standard.

He serves as a Trustee for Moravian Academy and sits on the Advisory Committee of the Saucon Valley Conservancy. Mr. Eighmy attended Middlebury College, Carnegie Mellon University, Graduate School of Industrial Administration, and Harvard University Graduate School of Design.
