Dana Buntrock is a Professor at the University of California, Berkeley. Currently a visiting professor in the Kengo Kuma lab while on sabbatical, she is also an Abe Fellow, funded by the Social Science Research Council. Buntrock has published two lengthy books on the subject of Japanese architecture and edited or contributed chapters to eight other books and three comprehensive encyclopedias. Buntrock's shorter critical reviews of buildings, exhibitions, and scholarship have been published around the world, in English, Spanish, Korean, Chinese and Japanese.

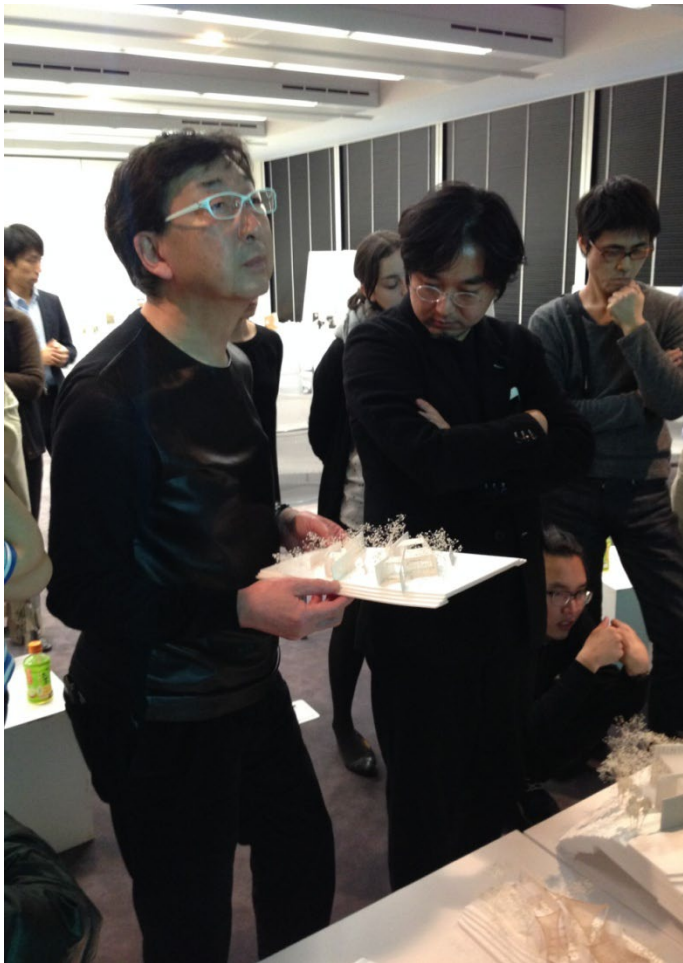
